From the desk of Monsignor Brouwers

CATECHETICAL SUNDAY

“Say the Word and my soul shall be healed”

This past year has highlighted the urgent need for healing on so many levels - physical, spiritual, emotional - in ourselves and in our world. As our world struggles to heal, we know that complete healing is not possible without Jesus as the Divine Physician. In fact, when our souls heal, we are strengthened, despite our suffering. The words we pray at Mass, “*Say the Word and My Soul Shall be Healed*”, have the power to remind us of and to open our eyes to the healing that Jesus offers us in the Eucharist which is essential, eternal, and ever open to us. We humbly ask him to say the word, and with that prayer, we have faith that, with the fantastic and improbable prospect of Jesus entering under our roof, our souls shall be healed.

This is one of the many lessons our children learn in our school and our parish religious education program (PREP). And so, on this Catechetical Sunday, we pray in a special way for our teachers and catechists who are charged with passing on the great gift of our faith to our children. Those whom the community has designated to serve as catechists will be called forth at the 9:30am Mass to be commissioned for their ministry.

I will also ask God’s blessing on all parents who are present as well, praying that God may strengthen them in their commitment to share the precious gift of their faith with their children. I ask that you join me in praying that they will embrace their mission with renewed enthusiasm. This is particularly important for our parents because, as the Second Vatican Council states so clearly, “parents must be acknowledged as the first and foremost educators of their children.” To emphasize this point, it goes on to say that “their role is so decisive that scarcely anything can compensate for their failure in it” (*Declaration on Christian Education*, §3). The teachers and catechists who will be commissioned this weekend can only reinforce and codify the lessons that parents teach their children at home, both by word and example. We, the parish staff, recognize this and so we try to work closely with the parents of our students in both our parish school and our PREP so that each of us can fulfill our proper role in raising our children in the ways of the faith.

This Sunday is a good opportunity for all of us to rededicate ourselves to this mission as a community of faith, not only to our children but to everyone because, as we recognize throughout our lives, we are all in need of ongoing catechesis and our current situation offers new challenges and new opportunities for growth in our faith. We come to Mass on Sunday to hear what we believe to be the Word of God in Scripture and to enter into what we believe to be communion with God through Jesus Christ, his Son. Since we believe in Jesus, the Word of Life and the Divine Healer, it is important for all of us to reflect on this and rededicate ourselves to this essential aspect of our baptismal call: being witnesses for Jesus Christ.

Catechetical Sunday is an important moment to reflect on the role that each person plays - by virtue of Baptism - in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel. It is an opportunity for all of us to rededicate ourselves to this mission as a community of faith. And, at this time, when we find ourselves turning to God even more anxiously as we continue to navigate the ongoing coronavirus pandemic, we become ever more aware of the importance of our faith in a loving and merciful God who always accompanies us in every moment of our lives and is particularly near to us in our times of trouble, ready to heal us with his powerful Word.

Catechesis is a distinct and special ministry in the Church. According to the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, catechesis is “an education of children, young people and adults in the faith of the Church through the teaching of Christian doctrine in an organic and systematic way to make them disciples of Jesus Christ.” As the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* makes clear, “Catechesis is intimately bound up with the whole of the Church’s life . . . her inner growth and correspondence with God’s plan depend essentially on catechesis” (§ 7). This ministry of teaching in the name of the Church has a profound dignity, which is why catechists are formally commissioned by the Church. It is most appropriate that we set aside a day to highlight this ministry and invite the entire Church community to think about our responsibility to share our faith with others.

In a world where so many have forgotten God or turned away from God, catechesis leads us to understand that God is essential in our lives. Especially today, when so many people are in need of healing, we can be witnesses of reliance in God who will protect us according to his divine plan. After all, God has made us all for Himself and, as St. Augustine said so well, our hearts are restless until they rest in God.

As we begin another school year, let's all rededicate ourselves to learning about and deepening our faith so that, strengthened by God's healing power, we may hand on to others what we have received from the Lord with renewed zeal. And, let me take this opportunity, in the name of our entire parish, to thank those who have heard the call to become catechists for our children; it is such an extremely important role you play in passing on the precious gift of our faith!

Dear SKS Parishioners,

The 2021 - 22 school year is under way and we are off to a great start.

Despite some Covid-19 restrictions, we are excited about the school year and in many ways we are better off than last year. We have reopened the library and the cafeteria. No masks have to be worn outside. The teachers are more able to teach the way they are accustomed to. CYO sports is back and after school clubs can take place. We have repurposed a room into a Technology/Stem Center. We have added a Learning Support Teacher to our staff.

We began the year with a prayer service in church and while we cannot have the entire school in church, we can accommodate three full grades in there. Everything we do starts with our faith and we recognize this with our commitment as a parish school that recognizes Christ as Lead Teacher. The school is just one component of this thriving parish and we are proud to be a part of a community whose pastor and parishioners believe in Catholic education and support us in every imaginable way. We are a blessed community and on behalf of our faculty/staff and school families, I thank all of our parishioners for your prayers and steady support.

Our school picture is bright. We have solid leadership in Msgr. Brouwers as pastor, a SKS Board of Limited Jurisdiction and Home and School Board. Enrollment remains well above 400+ with 250 families. Most are from SKS, yet 20% or so come from neighboring parishes that no longer have a school. Our dedicated faculty and staff remain to be the heart and soul of this building. It's never about the bricks and mortar but the people inside the building who are dedicated to teaching the whole child: spiritually, academically, socially, emotionally and physically. They do this with dedication, nurturing, and great love for children.

Here are a couple of pictures from the start of school including the Flag Folding Prayer Service to honor the fallen victims on the 20th anniversary of 9/11. It was a very touching service for our school.

I will keep in touch with you by way of the Parish Bulletin. I hope and pray your families are safe and well.
